Dear Residents and Main Street Parking Lot Patrons:

The *Chamber of Commerce Taste of Glen Ellyn* is scheduled to begin on Thursday May 18, 2017 in the Main Street parking lot. For this reason, the parking lot will **NOT** be available for parking, including overnight starting on Thursday, May 18, 2017 at 2:00 AM. The parking lot will be available for parking, including overnight parking, on Monday, May 22, 2017 at 5:00 AM.

DO NOT PARK IN THE LOT FOR OVERNIGHT PARKING ON WEDNESDAY MAY 17, 2017. VEHICLES LEFT IN THE PARKING LOT AFTER 2:00 AM ON THURSDAY MAY 18, 2017 WILL BE TICKETED AND TOWED. SET-UP FOR THE TASTE OF GLEN ELLYN STARTS VERY EARLY AND THE LOT NEEDS TO BE CLEARED.

STARTING ON WEDNESDAY MAY 17, 2017, DO NOT PARK OVERNIGHT ON MAIN STREET BETWEEN HILLSIDE AND DUANE. VEHICLES PARKED OVERNIGHT IN THIS AREA ARE SUBJECT TO TICKETING/TOWING.

DO NOT PARK OVERNIGHT ON HILLSIDE BETWEEN FOREST AND GLENWOOD AS THERE IS A RACE SCHEDULED FOR SATURDAY MAY 20, 2017 STARTING AT 8:00 AM – VEHICLES PARKED IN THIS AREA ARE SUBJECT TO BEING TICKETED AND/OR TOWED.

DO NOT PARK ON DUANE BETWEEN MAIN AND GLENWOOD AS THIS AREA IS BEING USED BY THE TASTE OF GLEN ELLYN ON SATURDAY MAY 20, 2017 AND SUNDAY MAY 21, 2017.

The Village realizes that the closing of Main Street and the Main Street parking lot may cause some inconvenience to those persons who normally park in these areas overnight. For this reason, temporary permission to park overnight has been granted on the following streets:

1. Duane St. between FOREST AND MAIN
2. Forest between DUANE AND HILL

**DO NOT PARK ON HILLSIDE BETWEEN FOREST AND GLENWOOD OVERNIGHT
DO NOT PARK ON DUANE BETWEEN MAIN AND GLENWOOD OVERNIGHT**

This temporary permission will be in effect between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. only while Main Street, the Main Street parking lot and portions of Duane Street are closed. Dear Village of Glen Ellyn Parking Customer:

The annual *Chamber of Commerce Taste of Glen Ellyn* and the *Jaycees Village Fair* are scheduled for next week. In order to accommodate these events, it is necessary to close two parking lots as well as an area designated as Employee Parking Only and Customer Parking Only. The following parking facilities, Employee Parking Only zone and Customer Parking Only zone will temporarily be closed/unavailable:

- Crescent & Glenwood lot from Sunday, May 14, 2017 at 6:00 P.M. through Monday, May 22, 2017 at 5:00 A.M.
- Crescent Bld. – Employee Parking Only and Customer Parking Only (between Glenwood and Prospect – south side of street) from Sunday May 14, 2017 at 6:00 P.M. through Monday May 22, 2017 at 5:00 A.M.
- Main Street lot (between Duane & Hillside) from Thursday, May 18, 2017 at 2:00 A.M. through Monday, May 22, 2017 at 5:00 A.M.
- Hillside Ave. – Employee Parking Only (on Hillside west of Main) from Friday, May 19, 2017 at 6:00 P.M. through Monday May 22, 2017 at 5:00 A.M.
- Main between Duane and Hillside from Friday May 20, 2017 at 6:00 A.M. through Monday May 22, 2017 at 5:00 A.M.
- Duane between Main and 507 Duane from Saturday May 21, 2017 at 0600 through Monday May 22, 2017 at 5:00 A.M.

The Village realizes that these parking facilities are important to you, and that closing them may cause some inconvenience. For these reasons, we are making the following suggestions:

Permit Parking Customers/Employee Parking Customers

You may park your car in any public parking lot marked for **PERMIT** parking during this period. In all cases, your current parking permit **must** be displayed. You should make every attempt **not to park** on the street or in areas marked for Customer Parking Only. If you should receive a parking ticket while following these instructions, please bring it to the Police Department. If we find that your permit was displayed and your car was not parked contrary to the stipulations above, you may be entitled to some relief.

Meter Users

As the map on the back of this letter shows, additional 3 hour meter parking is available in several parking lots located in the downtown area. Do not park in the area marked 'leased parking' or 'Employee Parking Only'. Parking is allowed in the 'permit area' **after 11:00 A.M. and in the 'Employee Parking Only' area after 6:00 P.M.** Free four hour parking is available on Forest north of Pennsylvania, Hillside between Main and Glenwood, and on Anthony between Pleasant and Park.
