**VILLAGE OF GLEN ELLYN HONORS OUTGOING VILLAGE BOARD MEMBERS  
AND SWEARS IN NEW OFFICIALS**

**Glen Ellyn, IL** – At the Glen Ellyn Village Board meeting on Monday, May 8, Village President Diane McGinley and Trustees Bill Enright, Gary Fasules and Craig Pryde, along with Village Clerk John Chereskin were sworn into office.

The newly sworn in Officials will serve a four-year term on the Village Board. McGinley previously served on the Board as a Trustee from 2011-2015, and more recently since November 2016.

“President Demos has pushed this Village far and above what we have been before and has left me in a great place to continue that tradition and forward momentum,” said Village President Diane McGinley. “I know this Board sitting up here, we are going to be successful.”

**Diane McGinley, Village President**

New Village President Diane McGinley has been an integral part of the Glen Ellyn community for 13 years. Diane is a substitute teacher for District 41, PTA President for Hadley Jr. High and served on the Village Board from 2011-15, and more recently since November 2016. **Bill Enright, Trustee**
