Upcoming Election Dates

March 20, 2018 - General Primary Election

Voter Registration

Tuesday, February 20, 2018: Last Day to Register to Vote by Paper Application You can register in person at local City, Village, or Township Halls in DuPage County or at the Election Commission office in addition to some local Libraries. Click <u>here</u> for a list of registration locations. When registering, be sure to bring two forms of identification with you, one of which must have your correct address on it.

Sunday, March 4, 2018: Last day to register to Vote by Online ApplicationVisit the <u>Illinois Online Voter Application</u> to register to vote online. The online application requires a valid Illinois Driver's license or State ID.

Grace Period Registration and Early Voting

Illinois law provides individuals who were unable to register to vote by the March 4 deadline, a "grace period" to register and vote simultaneously. The schedule is below:

- March 5, 2018 to March 19, 2018: Election Commission Office (421 N. County Farm Road, Wheaton)
- March 5, 2018 March 17, 2018: Designated Early Voting Locations (Glen Ellyn Civic Center, 535 Duane Street, is an early voting location). A full listing of Early Voting locations can be found here.
- March 20, 2018: Voter's designated polling place on Election Day. To find your polling location, visit the <u>voter services website</u>.

Absentee Voting

March 15, 2018: Last Day to Request a Mail Ballot
