



that cannot be accepted and the fact that they should be directed to the DuPage County website and/or be informed about the West Chicago event where electronics will be accepted. Pizza and coffee will be supplied at the event by the Village.

**5. Chairman's Report –**

Chairman Marcott informed the Commission that there will be an Earth Day event at the Library on Thursday, April 22 from 7-8:30pm. Information about the event will be on the Library website. He encouraged all Commission members to attend. He also informed the Commission that Bike to Work Day is coming up. Staff Liaison Schrader believed the date of the event was June 15. She will confirm and send out an email. Chairman Marcott asked Staff Liaison Schrader if there was any word on the budget request. Staff Liaison Schrader informed the Commission that the Board did make a decision and they will be giving the Environmental Commission \$2,000 for use towards the Rain Barrel Program. The funds will be available May 1.

Commissioner Glaza stated that rather than subsidizing \$80 towards each rain barrel (which would only provide a grant to 25 residents) the Commission should provide grants that are \$40. That way they can double the number of rain barrel grants they provide. Commission members agreed this was a good idea and Staff Liaison Schrader said the Commission can do this without Board approval. Further detail will be discussed at the next meeting.

**6. Trustee Liaison Report –**

Trustee Liaison Hartweg informed the Commission the new Budget will be adopted on Monday, April 26 and recapped the various road repair projects that are currently ongoing.

**7. Staff Liaison Report –**

Staff Liaison Schrader informed the Commission they will be sent two packets in May. One will be regarding the Tree Preservation Ordinance (T.P.O.) and the other will be the regular packet. The T.P.O will be sent a few weeks ahead of the meeting so Commission members have a chance to review. She also informed the Commission that the Village has received \$18,000 since January in recycling rebates. Everyone agreed it was good news that recycling has picked up.

**8. Confirmation of Next Meeting Date and Adjournment –**

The next scheduled regular meeting will be held on May 18, 2010. A motion was made by Commissioner Glaza, seconded by Commissioner Kreuzer, to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 p.m.
