TREE PRESERVATION

The subcommittee discussed issues and proposals to limit the mass cutting of trees for development or other purposes on residential lots. The following language was discussed as a potential ordinance proposal:

Any owner of property who does not personally reside on the property as their primary/principal residence (defined as at least six consecutive months during the last two years) may not remove a tree with a trunk DBH of 4” or greater on private property without a municipal permit and they will only be allowed to remove a tree if the tree is considered in decline, dead, or diseases as determined by the Village.

The subcommittee will meet again for further discussion on the suggested language.
