

**MINUTES OF JUNE 29, 2010 TREE PRESERVATION
SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING**

The subcommittee discussed issues and proposals to limit the mass cutting of trees for development or other purposes on residential lots. The following language was reviewed and discussed as a potential ordinance proposal:

Any owner of property who does not personally reside on the property as their primary/principal residence (defined as at least six consecutive months during the last two years) may not remove a tree with a trunk DBH of 4" or greater on private property without a municipal permit and they will only be allowed to remove a tree if the tree is considered in decline, dead, disease or otherwise compromised as determined by the Village.

The subcommittee also discussed whether to, and means to, restrict an owner's ability to remove some number of trees (four to six?) in the same year. Setback issues were discussed.
