



**B. Spring Lawn Care Seminar –**

Chairman Glaza informed members that attendance at the seminar was good with about 50-60 people in attendance. She also informed members that she would like to develop a better relationship with the library and possibly partner with them to generate a greater interest with its patrons. All agree this is a good idea.

**C. Commercial Recycling -**

Commissioner Kreuzer updated members on DuPage County's pilot program for commercial recycling and how the County would like towns to participate. He went on to talk about equipment, advertising and funding available to help municipalities who participate in the program. He would like to see Glen Ellyn be one of the towns in the forefront of developing a program in partnership with the County. All members think this is a good idea.

**5. Chairman's Report –**

Chairman Neary goes over the proposed Tree Preservation Ordinance (TPO) with the group and what was presented to the most recent Board Workshop. She also goes over points in the TPO she believed were not appropriately representative of what the Commission voted for. The group discussed points referenced by Chairman Neary, what happened at the most recent Board Workshop and what direction it seems the Board would like to go with the TPO. After much discussion all members agree to review the current TPO and email points they have concerns with to Chairman Neary. She will compile concerns and send to Staff Liaison Letson by the end of the week. Staff Liaison Schrader informed the Commission that the Board will not discuss the TPO until the June 27 workshop and the most updated version of the TPO is dated May 13.

**6. Trustee Liaison Report –**

Trustee Liaison Hartweg updated the Commission on newly elected Village Trustees, C.O.D. and the new Village Manager.

**7. Staff Liaison Report –**

Staff Liaison Schrader informed the Commission this would be her last meeting. Administrative Intern Andrew Letson will now be the staff liaison to the Commission.

**8. Confirmation of Next Meeting Date and Adjournment –**

The next scheduled regular meeting will be held on June 21, 2011. A motion was made by Commissioner Glaza, seconded by Commissioner Westcott to adjourn the meeting at 9:24 p.m. Members wonder if there will be a quorum in July.
