- 1. Call Meeting to Order –**

- 4. Continuing Business –**
  - A. Review of Recycling Extravaganza –**  
Members reviewed the most recent Extravaganza and thanked Commissioner Pellico for all of his hard work. Members discussed changes they believed might help the Extravaganza run smoother next year such as redirecting traffic, roping off various sections and the flow of the book exchange. Commissioner Rahn had some specific suggestions for the book exchange such as using tubs for smaller items. Members also discussed the future date for the event, coordinating this with C.O.D.'s hazardous waste day, Glen Ellyn's Amnesty's day, Prairie Path Clean up and anything going on at the County. It was decided to hold the next Extravaganza on April 28, 2012. It was also requested that the Village's Clean Sweep event be pushed back to early May to ensure that people have an incentive to recycle rather than just throw things away. Members also discussed getting a dry cleaner involved (since so many hangers were turned in), a battery vendor, a plastics vendor and having some kind of shredding event. Commissioner Pellico believed the space could be used more efficiently to accommodate additional vendors. Members start talking about suppliers but conversation is abruptly stopped.
