IV. Glen Ellyn's Purchasing Policy

Chairman Parker led the purchasing policy discussion. He asked Interim Finance Director Noller to review current Village approval limits as well as the approval limits of the peer communities. Also discussed were the volume and dollar amounts of invoices processed by the Village in the last fiscal year. The Commissioners were in general agreement to recommend considering an increase in department director spending authority to \$5,000 in order to improve efficiency and subject to final review in August.

V. Scorecard Update

Discussions continued on the best way for the financial scorecard to be maintained by the Village. Interim Village Manager Burghard stated that the current administration intern could be utilized in helping with the update process.

VI. Other Business

Interim Finance Director Noller reviewed the 2010 property tax FAQ sheets that will be added to the Village website and requested any comments from Commissioners.
