

MINUTES of POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
Wednesday, 17 August 2016

A special meeting of the Glen Ellyn Police and Fire Commission was held in the Glen Ellyn Police Station on Wednesday, August 17, 2016. The meeting convened at 3:45 PM with Chairman James Meyers presiding, and Secretary Wesley Peters, member Cynthia Steinbach and Sgt. Jean Harvey of the Glen Ellyn Police Department attending.

The minutes of the meeting on April 20, 2016 were presented and approved as printed.

Based on background information collected up to this point in time, the Commission voted not to move forward in the hiring process with candidate #341.

Member Steinbach moved that the Commission move into Executive Session for the purpose of interviewing Police Officer candidates. It was so voted. Following the interviews with those applicants and discussion regarding the applicants, Member Peters moved we return to Open Session. It was so voted.

The Commission voted to move forward in the hiring process with candidate #226. The Commission voted not to move forward in the hiring process with candidates #124 and #300.

It was acknowledged that the Police Officer Eligibility List of December 22, 2014 has been exhausted. It will be necessary to plan for publicizing and testing so that a new Eligibility List can be established before the end of the year.

No date was set for the next meeting of the Commission.

The meeting adjourned at 6:10 PM.
