

Commissioner Jourdan commented on the quality of the service in the restaurant on a recent Saturday night. There was general discussion concerning the level of staffing, the jobs of those persons on the floor, and methods of educating the staff. Manager Pekarek said that they currently lack having persons available whose sole job is to direct workers on the floor. He would like one manager on the patio and one in the interior coaching and observing. The staffing positions are not set and they are working on addressing that issue.

Commissioner Graham commented on whether or not there would be noise problems in the dining room once the outside is no longer usable. There was also discussion concerning heaters on the patio. Manager Pekarek said that he has asked the architect about both matters. Sunday brunch will be starting on September 29 with hours approximately 8:00 AM to Noon or 1:00 PM. In the past, breakfast has not covered the cost to provide it. There was also discussion concerning the number of NFL games that could be received simultaneously. At this time, the maximum number of games available from Comcast is being shown. Also, questions were asked about a location for cigar or cigarette smoking on the patio or elsewhere outside. Manager Pekarek said cigar smoking will probably be banned and cigarette smoking in a designated area only, and the decisions will err on the side of restricting it.
