Theft Over \$500

A manager of the business reported being a victim of a telephone scam. Unknown caller claimed to be an employee of ComEd demanding payment for the utility bill. Victim deposited \$1500 into a Bitcoin machine and was later sent a barcode so the money could be transferred. The victim later received another call requesting an additional \$1899 be sent. At that time ComEd was contacted and it was determined that the call was a hoax.

500 Blk of Williamsburgh

Theft Over \$500

Resident reported being the victim of a telephone scam. Unknown caller claimed to be an employee of Microsoft and demanded the victim purchase Target and Walmart gift cards to remove fraudulent charges made on a credit card. Victim purchased \$10,000 worth of gift cards and provided activation codes. One of the gift cards valued at \$2000 was not used at the time of the report.



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400 Blk of Raintree

Theft Over \$500

Resident reported being the victim of an internet scam. Victim gave caller remote access to his computer and then logged into his bank account. Offender transferred \$3000 from the victim's savings account into victim's checking account and then instructed him to purchase \$2700 in Target gift cards for which he provided the caller with the activation codes.
