THIRD SUSPECT IN KIDNAPPING HAS BEEN ARRESTED

Jeremy Jones, the third suspect in a kidnapping that occurred on August 26, 2016 in Glen Ellyn, has been arrested in Chicago and is in custody in Cook County on unrelated charges.

In the Glen Ellyn incident, it is alleged that Jones, along with two other accomplices, used a handgun while abducting a Wheaton College student from a north side Glen Ellyn neighborhood. The three men are further alleged to have driven the victim to several ATM's where they removed approximately \$1500 from the victim's accounts before letting him go in Chicago. An arrest warrant was issued for Jones on September 2, 2016, alleging the crimes of Aggravated Kidnapping, Aggravated Unlawful Restraint, and Armed Robbery. Jones' accomplices, 18-year-old Abeet Ramos and a male juvenile, are already in custody.

Members of the public are reminded that a criminal complaint contains only charges and is not proof of the defendant's guilt. A defendant is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial during which it is the government's burden to prove his/her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
