A Residential Security Survey is an inspection of your home, performed by a specially trained police officer, in an effort to identify areas in which you could improve the physical security of your residence. Many security features may be discussed, ranging from simply trimming shrubbery, to changing locks and upgrading exterior lighting. Recommendations may be made to improve the security of your home. There are no obligations to the resident to perform any of the recommendations.

The survey is offered free to Glen Ellyn residents, by appointment only. It generally takes less than an hour.
