The Village recently paved your street and now plans to protect the asphalt surface with Reclamite, a liquid rejuvenating agent. The purpose of this surface treatment is to prolong the life of the pavement and reduce the life cycle cost of the roadway. It is anticipated that the work will be performed in September.

The process begins with the contractor providing a hand-delivered notification (placed at your door) one (1) to two (2) days before the commencement of the work. Signs and barricades will be placed to close the roadway and prevent parking and driving on the street during application and absorption of the rejuvenating agent. A distributor truck equipped with a special spray bar will apply the rejuvenating agent as the truck drives down each side of the street. Once the rejuvenating agent is applied, it takes 30 to 90 minutes to be absorbed into the asphalt surface. Sand is then applied to the street, after which the contractor will open the roadway to traffic.

To prevent delays to your travel plans, it is recommended that you have your vehicle out of your driveway and off the street between 7 am and 5 pm on the day(s) specified in the notification provided by the contractor. If you do not require use of your vehicle on these dates, you can leave it parked in your driveway but not on the street. **Parking is not permitted on streets being treated.** You can park on streets not identified on the map as being treated and you will not receive a parking ticket.

While the rejuvenating agent is being absorbed, the street is completely closed to traffic. **If the street is driven on after the Reclamite is applied, but before the street is sanded, then tires will track the Reclamite onto concrete or brick paver driveways. This is why the street is temporarily closed.** If you drive on a street just treated with Reclamite and while it is being absorbed into the asphalt, you should proceed with caution. Do not pull into a driveway as the material will track as previously indicated. Once sand has been applied to the street, tracking will not occur, and the street and driveways can be driven on without concern. In a couple of days the sand will be swept away with a street sweeper.

All work will be performed Tuesday - Friday, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. This work cannot be performed when the street is wet, so if it rains the work will occur the following day. A map of all the streets included in the project is located on the reverse side of this notice. It will take approximately two days to complete all the streets shown on the map.

The company that will perform this work for the village is called Corrective Asphalt Materials, LLC. (CAM LLC). They have performed this same work for various other communities in the region.
