VILLAGE OF GLEN ELLYN APPROVES NEW ELECTRICITY CONTRACT

Glen Ellyn, IL – The Village of Glen Ellyn approved a 15 month contract with Dynegy as the Village's new energy supplier after receiving multiple bids from energy companies through the Electric Aggregation Program. The new contract with Dynegy will go into effect August 1, 2017 and expire in October 2018.

Eligible participants, which includes all residents and qualified small businesses, are eligible for two supply options - a Renewable option where 100 percent of the energy comes from renewable energy sources and a Traditional rate where the energy is supplied through traditional generation sources. All participants will be automatically enrolled in the Renewable energy program unless a call to Dynegy is made to request the Traditional energy option.

- **Standard Rate** (auto-enrollment) for the Renewable (Green) Power Program is **\$0.07185 per kWh** and is guaranteed until October 2018.
- **Optional Rate** for the lower-priced Traditional Power Program is **\$0.06993 per kWh** and is guaranteed until October 2018. If you prefer this alternative, eligible participants must call Dynegy directly to select this lower-priced option.

Eligible participants who do not wish to utilize Dynegy as an energy supplier have the ability to "opt out" at any time if they wish to select an alternate energy supplier or revert back to ComEd. Those who are currently in the Municipal Electric Aggregation Program for Glen Ellyn, as well as ratepayers currently receiving power supply through ComEd, will receive a letter in the mail from the Village of Glen Ellyn and Dynegy during the week of June 12 that will explain the details on how to continue participation in the program, choose the Traditional Power Program or how to opt-out entirely.

As in the past, residents will still continue to receive one monthly bill generated by ComEd, and will continue to receive electricity delivery services from ComEd. Any outages should continue to be reported directly to ComEd.
