Glen Ellyn Appoints New General Manager at Village Links/Reserve 22

Vesevick brings with him a strong track record, having already served a 20+ year career at the Village Links, where he most recently served as the Assistant Department Head/Director of Golf. Vesevick is a Class A member of the Professional Golfers Association of America ("PGA"), and became a Certified PGA Professional in General Management in 2011. He is a graduate of Elmhurst College, where he received his B.A. in Business Administration. Vesevick is married, and has three children. He is also a graduate of Glenbard East High School, and lives with his wife and youngest son in Wheaton.

The Village is excited to have Vesevick overseeing the Village's awarding wining golf and restaurant operation, and looks forward to him being an integral part of the Village's senior management team. Vesevick stated, "I am both honored, and excited to be given the opportunity to work in this new capacity along-side the very talented and dedicated professionals who work at the Village and Village Links/Reserve 22.
