Theft Over \$500

Four women reportedly entered the store and left carrying diapers and other infant care-related products. The suspects are described as follows:

Suspect 1: Black female, skinny, late 30's to early 40's, with her hair in a bun, wearing a blue t-shirt, white striped pants, sandals, carrying an oversized white purse.
